## The following will be in place:

## Restrictions

- Foods must be in pack from reliable stores or manufacturers, sealed and not opened including water and beverages. Candies are allowed but sealed.
- *Expired dates must be checked on the label and should not distributed.*
- Home baked goods and beverages are strictly prohibited or not allowed.

Food distribution area and cleanup.

- Distribution of foods must be during after school only to avoid foods scattered in the classrooms and students will be ready for school.
- Competing district / school provided breakfast and lunch are not allowed.
- There should one place for distribution recognized by the school. The area for distribution of foods will be marked as "Food Distribution Area" no other places.
- Packaging, leftover, thrown foods must be picked and take it home.
- Bring your own trash bag for packing. The distribution area must be clear from trash.

Food preparation and distribution time.

2:00 PM - register your foods in the office. This is for tracking if there are complaints.
2:30 PM - food preparation at the designated area.
3:05- 3:10 - distribution of foods to students.
3:15 PM - food distribution is over. Students going to AHA are ready for class.
2:30-3:30 Friday, Oct. 4, 2024. Last distribution of foods, candies, beverages and bottled water.
